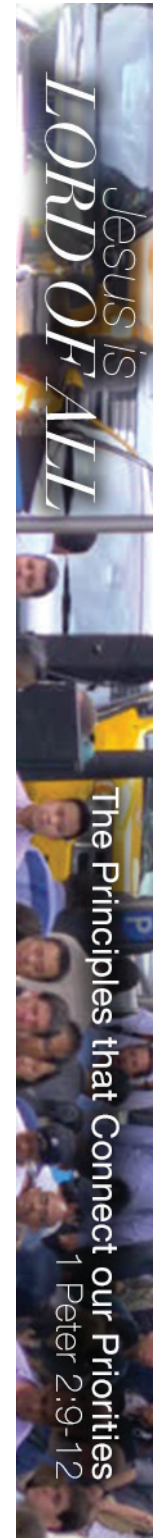
4. In what way are we sojourners and exiles in the world? (v.11) How ought this influence the way we live?
