7. Do you feel like you're currently living on mission for Jesus? If not, what things do you need to change to make that happen?

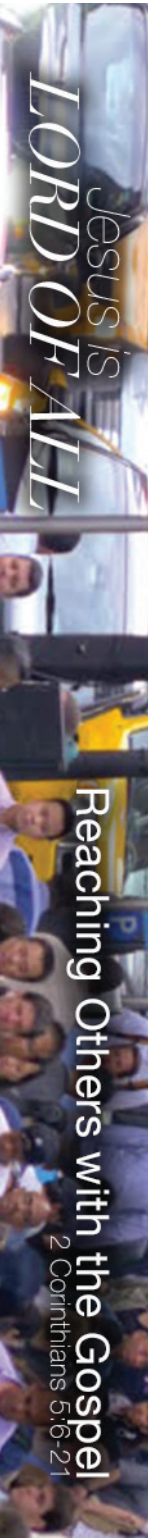
