QUESTIONS

ICEBREAKER: What music do you put on when you want to get pumped?

1. John 1:18 states an obstacle in the first phrase. However, it is overcome in the rest of the verse. What are the 3 descriptions of Jesus listed in this verse and what difference do they make [cf. Matthew 11:27; John 1:14; and John 6:46]?
2. Philip's question was profound, yet unnecessary in John 14:8&9. He desired to experience God personally and directly. But Jesus responded by making an astonishing claim. What was that claim, and what does it reveal about Jesus [cf. John 10:30; John 12:44-45; and Colossians 1:15]?
3. How is our Triune God revealed and described in John 14:25-26? Also consult Luke 24:49; John 15:26; and Acts 2:33]?
4. In Paul's prayer in Colossians 1:11-14, he gave thanks to the Father for several blessings. What are those blessings that belong to all believers, and why are they significant [cf. Acts 26:18; Ephesians 5:8; and 1 Peter 2:9]?
5. What is the source of the spiritual blindness of our world according to 2 Corinthians 4:4-6, and what is the only remedy to restore spiritual sight [cf. Matthew 13:19; 2 Corinthians 3:14; and Ephesians 2:1-3]?
6. Hebrews 1:1-4 is one of the richest texts in all of Scripture extolling the identity and ministry of our Lord Jesus. How is He described in these verses, and what impact does it make in your life [cf. John 1:3; 1 Corinthians 8:6; and Colossians 1:16-17]?
7. What did you find helpful or challenging about this Sunday's message?
